



TOWNSHIP OF PERRY
BURNING BY-LAW REGULATIONS

(By-law 2017-13)

NEW

Fire Permits are **no longer** required for recreational fires (Campfires)

NEW

Approval is required if the pile is greater than 2 metres (6.5 ft.) in diameter and 2 metres (6.5 ft.) in height **and** for burning during prohibited times and must be approved by the Chief Fire Official.

- **NO DAYTIME BURNING** from **April 1st to October 31st** a fire is only allowed to burn between the hours of **6:00 pm. in the evening to 10:00 am in the morning.**
- A recreational open air burning area shall only be **2 ft.** by **2 ft.** in size.
- A recreational fire shall **only** burn the following materials:
 - ♦ Commercially produced charcoal ♦ briquettes ♦ clean dry seasoned wood
- The following items **cannot** be burned:
 - ♦ painted wood ♦ pressure treated wood ♦ creosote treated wood
 - ♦ yard waste ♦ wood that is larger in size than the fire pit or burning device
- Every person shall have immediately available an **effective extinguishing agent** or **device** for extinguishing the fire.
- A fire shall be **attended**, **controlled** and **supervised** at all times by a **competent adult** until the fire **is extinguished.**
- The **property owner** is **liable** if the fire is not contained/monitored.

Any fire is not permitted during a fire ban.
