Did You Know...?

- All Recycling goes to Waste Connections in Bracebridge, where it is further separated and baled into saleable commodities for reuse by manufacturing companies.
- All Containers should be rinsed out prior to recycling. This helps to keep contamination out of the recycling stream, avoiding additional costs to the Township in the form of residual fees.
- The Transfer Station is not licensed to process household compost. Our compost pile is for leaf and yard waste only. Please include all food compost with your household waste, or consider your own backyard compost.
- Removing recycling from Resident vehicles by Attendants is prohibited due to safety and liability concerns. If you require assistance unloading your vehicle, please ensure you bring someone with you to help.
- The interior of the building may contain safety hazards due to slippery floors or machinery. Please be aware of warning signs and keep clear of any equipment that is running.
