

IMPORTANT COMMUNITY WARNING

Stronger Purple Heroin (“Purp”) Suspected in North Bay and West Nipissing

Between July 1 and 14, there were 6 reported overdoses involving purple heroin in West Nipissing and the City of North Bay. Most of the 6 overdoses needed 3 doses of naloxone to revive the person. Purple heroin or “purp” is the combination of heroin, OxyCotin, and fentanyl or carfentanil.
