# <u>Item 4.4 Annette Gilpin, Perry Township Public Library CEO – TD StoryWalk</u> <u>2023 and Other Library Updates</u>

Annette Gilpin, Perry Township Public Library CEO, presented the following information to Council.

Youth Advisory Committee (YAC):

- The Library's YAC, which currently has 15 members between the ages of 11-15, has been investigating ways to promote community programs and initiatives to support the youth within the Township of Perry;
- By engaging with the community, it was realized that parents are bringing sandbox toys with them to the Emsdale Park each time they visit, or leaving older toys for other children;
- To assist families, YAC is proposing that a toy Sand Box Library be installed on the grounds of the Alphabet Park in Emsdale;
- YAC would build the Sand Box Library, with assistance from volunteers and with donated material;
- The proposed Sand Box Library would hold a variety of sandbox toys shovels, buckets, dump trucks, etc. – that children would play with and then return to the shelter.

## TD StoryWalk 2023:

- As in year's past, the Library is proposing that the TD StoryWalk placards be installed at the Novar Community Park for children and families to enjoy all summer long;
- The 2023 story is "Treasure" by Mireille Messier and Irene Luxbacher and contains 18 panels total;
- The StoryWalk has been well received by the community in past years and many families are looking forward to the program again in 2023.

Acting Mayor MacPhail thanked Ms. Gilpin for her presentation and noted that many children who participate in T-Ball and Softball in Novar love reading the TD StoryWalk while they attend practice.
